2009 Cabernet Sauvignon



Varietal: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard location: Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza

Altitude: 3,118 feet above sea level

Harvest: Handpicked grapes in 44 lbs boxes.

Aging: 6 months in second and third use French and American oak.

Alcohol: 14.5% by volume

Tasting Notes:

Intense ruby red color and complex fruit aromas.

On the palate, notes of cassis and cherries predominate. Subtle flavors of pepper, vanilla and tobacco. Nicely structured. Sweet and ripe tannins give way to a concentrated, lingering finish.
