Vineyard:

Situated in the Calchaquíes Valley in northwest Argentina at 6,400 feet above sea level. The intense ultraviolet sunlight at this altitude results in intensely flavorful and aromatic grapes.

Climate:

Scant rainfall, year round sunshine, with wide spreads between day and night temperatures .

Average daytime temperatures range from 77-87°F

Average annual rainfall: 3-4 inches

Soil: Sandy soil providing excellent drainage.
