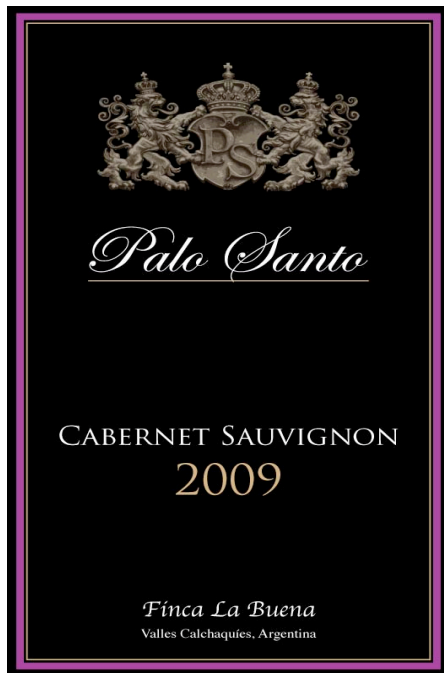


Palo Santo

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2009



Grape variety: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Alcohol: 13.8%

Total acidity: 5.62 g/l

pH: 3.6

Wood: Oak

Age of vines: 11 years

Tasting notes: Fruity with flavors of crushed black currents and notes of green pepper leading to a full-bodied finish. Aged in American Oak for 6 months.

Vineyard:

Situated in the Calchaquies Valley in northwest Argentina at 6,400 feet above sea level. The intense ultraviolet sunlight at this altitude results in intensely flavorful and aromatic grapes.

Climate:

Scant rainfall, year round sunshine, with wide spreads between day and night temperatures.

Average daytime temperatures range from 77-87°F

Average annual rainfall: 3-4 inches

Soil: Sandy soil providing excellent drainage.
