Grape variety: 75% Cabernet, 25% Merlot

Alcohol: 14.0%

Total acidity: 6.37g/l

pH: 3.7

Wood: Oak

Age of vines: 11 years

Tasting notes: Deep garnet with layers of blackberry, plum and mocha. Lush and smokey. Aged in American oak for 6 months.

Vineyard:

Situated in the Calchaquies Valley in northwest Argentina at 6,400 feet above sea level. The intense ultraviolet sunlight at this altitude results in intensely flavorful and aromatic grapes.

Climate:

Scant rainfall, year round sunshine, with wide spreads between day and night temperatures.

Average daytime temperatures range from 77-87°F

Average annual rainfall: 3-4 inches

Soil: Sandy soil providing excellent drainage.
