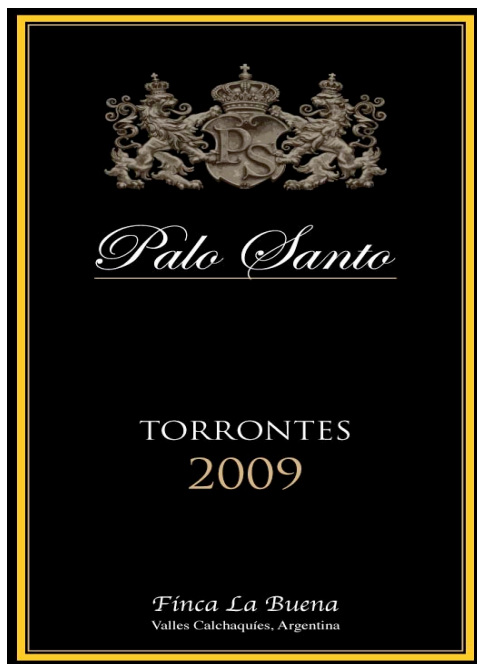


# *Palo Santo*

## TORRONTES 2009



Grape variety: 100% Torrontes

Alcohol: 13.2%

Total acidity: 5.66 g/l

pH: 3.2

Wood: none

Age of vines: 30 years

Tasting notes: Floral aromas give way to citrus and tropical fruit with mineral notes. Torrontes is the iconic grape of the region.

### Vineyard:

Situated in the Calchaquies Valley in northwest Argentina at 6,400 feet above sea level. The intense ultraviolet sunlight at this altitude results in intensely flavorful and aromatic grapes.

### Climate:

Scant rainfall, year round sunshine, with wide spreads between day and night temperatures.

Average daytime temperatures range from 77-87°F

Average annual rainfall: 3-4 inches

Soil: Sandy soil providing excellent drainage.
